AMR Board Meeting Minutes

AMR Board of Directors Meeting, March 25, 2025

The Alpine Mountain Region Board of Directors met on Mar 25th, 2025 at Old Chicago Pizza and Taproom. The meeting was convened at 5:58 pm and adjourned it at 6:45 pm.

Previous Meeting Minutes: Minutes of Feb 25th meeting were approved. All 2025 minutes will be published on the AMR website once reconstruction is complete. That is expected to finish in May 2025.

Committee Reports:

Treasury: Pam presented the treasurer's report. Feb income was \$4889; expenses were \$7941. Filed taxes and paid trailer registration. Primarily, expenses were for website and future HPDE's. Approved by voice vote. Subsequent discussion identified a need for our own tables for various events. Board approved \$350 for Jackie to procure tables.

Registrar: Twenty six have signed up for HPDE 101, Santa Fe tour and April Social are now open for registrations.

HPDE Program: HPDE Instructors meeting/training at Pueblo, 29 March. Sixty instructors/candidates have signed up. This is being held jointly with RMR. National HPDE chair is expected to attend.

Safety – No new discussions.

Membership: 801 Total AMR, 510 Primary, 291 Co-members, 35 Junior, 165,569 National Total

Socials: April social will be Friday, 25 April at Vaquero's off North Gate. May social will be on Friday, 30 May at Big Mission in Palmer Lake. (Maximum will be 100)

50th Anniversary of AMR will be Saturday 28 June at Carter Payne. Discussed costs, ways to reduce cost, and potential club contribution to offset member cost. Brenda requested board members meet at the venue to assess the property and meal plans. A Saturday was suggested. Steve suggested that a Concours be held and that a recent member transferring from the Chicago region, Rich Lamar, has experience in judging.

Working to schedule socials the rest of the year. Perry Park is being considered for September. The Warehouse was previously approved for the Christmas Social on Saturday, 6 Dec.

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Tours: Jackie reported that Nicole Kurashov was assisting her in establishing tours this summer. Bishop's Castle tour budget was approved by email on 17 March. Santa Fe tour budget was approved by email on 13 March. Considering a Pueblo Farmer's Market tour which has been very popular in the past. Planning for a September Steamboat tour is in progress.

Charities: Donations to TESSA were 27 items and \$265 in March. April donations will also go to Tessa.

Website: Website services are being contracted out. Board previously approved a budget of \$3850 for monthly services through 2025. Website reconstruction will be a separate charge with completion expected in May.
