While getting organized, AMR held its first board meeting of the year last Wednesday evening, January 27. Normally, it is on a Tuesday, but mother nature decided to give us some much needed moisture and not so needed cold, so we decided to delay the meeting a day for everyone's safety. Meeting minutes should be approved and posted to our website soon. We are still working on details for the year's event calendar and we should have everything set in stone by the middle of February... at least as firm as it can be, given our continued restrictions due to the pandemic.

Additionally, the track management at Pueblo is still in negotiations with the city, so the track is not taking reservations yet, so those dates are also tentative.

All of this upheaval means we still have a number of unknowns right now, but we are hopeful we can pull things off as scheduled. 
Werks Reunion Amelia Island
